**Hendersonville** – The Henderson County Sheriff's Office K-9 Team working at the request of and in conjunction with the principal at West Henderson High School conducted vehicle searches throughout the morning of Thursday, March 29.

The searches were conducted by K-9 Team Leader Deputy Danny Godman, K-9 Team Member Deputy Jason Garren and West Henderson School Resource Officer Deputy Steve Geyer. Again, these searches were conducted at the request and in cooperation with the principal at West Henderson High School. As a result of these searches 16-year-old Joshua Park, 17-year-old Casey Walker and 18-year-old Roman Reed were arrested and charged with Simple Possession of a Schedule VI Controlled Substance and drug paraphernalia. Each received a \$500 secured bond; Reed and Park remain in the Henderson County Detention Center.

"This is a great example of how Henderson County Public Schools and the Henderson County Sheriff's Office can work together to positively impact and work to eradicate the drug issues facing our school students today. Everyone needs to know that drugs will not be tolerated in Henderson County and especially in our schools" says Sheriff Rick Davis.
